PHONICS · SILENT e WORD BUILDER

Convert short-vowel words into long-vowel words using silent e.

Trim on red lines, fold on blue. Trim out e strip, and paste or tape on back side of foldover panel.

To help understand and memorize the transition between a short- and a long-vowel sound, you can make up a silly rhyme including the short-vowel and long-vowel word.

Example: There was a *man* with a *mane*. I have a *pet* named *Pete*. Let's buy a *kit* for a *kite*. That's *not* my favorite *note*. She put the *tub* in a *tube*.
